#### I. Administrative

a. Call to Order: President Kelly Cook, CEC, AAC called the General Session to order at 8:33 am.

- d. Sergeant at Arms: Jack Bretzke, CEC, AAC was appointed as Sergeant at Arms.
- **e. Welcome:** President Cook, CEC, AAC welcomed those in attendance and acknowledged the difficulties faced over the past 16 months, due to the Covid pandemic. He expressed joy in seeing everyone in-person and pride in the fact that Chefs have stepped up to meet the challenges of the current day.
- **f. Review of Minutes:** President Cook, CEC, AAC referenced the minutes from the 2020 General Session. Cook requested a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Jason Avelson, CCC, CCE presented a motion, which was seconded by Patrick Mitchell, CEC, AAC and approved by the members.
- **g.** Agenda Approval: Cook reviewed the General Session agenda and asked for additions and/or revisions. Gene Christiano, CEC presented a motion to approve the agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Michael Scott, CEC, AAC and approved by the membership.

#### II. Report of the Officers

- **a. Chairman of the Board:** Mark Schneider, CEC, AAC reported no grievances and expressed his pleasure in serving as Chairman of the Board of the Texas Chefs Association.
- b. President: President Cook referenced the recent ACF National Convention in Orlando, Florida. He stated that Chapter Presidents conducted a breakout session for the first time to discuss how individual Chapters can support each. Additionally, the Chapter Presidents stressed the importance of gaining a voice at the national level. The Convention hosted approximately 550 attendees inperson and an additional 500 participated virtually. Despite the fact that Texas Chefs didn't win any competitions, Cook stated that the TCA was well represented and he acknowledged those who participated. Cook acknowledged that the ACF had sold their office building and purchased a smaller facility in the Jacksonville, FL area. Additionally, the ACF staff has been reduced. These measures were taken to address the significant debt faced by the ACF. President Cook congratulated Victoria Hooker, CCC, CCE and the Byron Nelson High School for becoming an ACF accredited program. Finally, President Cook thanked Caroline Taylor and Heather Kurima for their efforts in organizing the 63<sup>rd</sup> TCA State Convention in Fort Worth, TX.
- c. 1st Vice President: Len Pawelek, CEC referenced our Culinary Vision Partners and State Convention sponsors. He expressed the importance of supporting our partners and referenced our 2021 CVP partners as follows:

Finally, Chef Pawelek acknowledged how the TCA has benefitted him personally and professionally and thanked the members for their support.

- d. 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President: Rick Neal, CEC thanked Caroline Taylor, Heather Kurima and the Fort Worth Chapter for hosting the State Convention. Neal referenced the TCA membership survey and encouraged the membership to provide their feedback. The survey results will be used to conduct a strategic plan for the direction of the TCA. Chef Neal stated that a marketing committee had been formed to evaluation TCA branding and how the association can reach the next generation of Chefs. The committee includes Heather Kurima, Larry Delgado and Rick Neal. Additionally, the committee is in discussion with NewChef to offer TCA branded merchandise. In conclusion, Rick Neal, CEC acknowledged Morris Salerno, HAAC and Patrick Mitchell, CEC, AAC for their recent honors at the American Academy of Chefs dinner.
- **e. Secretary/Treasurer:** Mark Schneider, CEC, CCE, AAC stated that the association is financially stable. Schneider addressed the balance sheet and restricted accounts, which had balances as follows:

Chef Schneider explained that funds from the Bernard Urban and Patrick Mitchell restricted accounts had been combined to create one account for local, regional, national and international competitions. The Willy Rossel restricted account funds have been assigned to the TCA marketing initiative. Schneider continued to address the income statement activity. Patrick Mitchell, CEC, AAC presented a motion to approve the financial reports. The motion was seconded by Morris Salerno, HAAC and approved by the membership.

- **a. State Officer Elections:** President Cook announced two uncontested candidates for the offices of TCA President and 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President. Rick Neal, CEC presented a motion to name Len Pawelek, CEC as President of the Texas Chefs Association. The motion was seconded by Mark Schneider, CEC, AAC and approved unanimously by the membership. Robert Hale presented a motion to name Mark Schneider, CEC, AAC as 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President of the Texas Chefs Association. The motion was seconded by Steve DeShazo, CEC, FMP and approved unanimously by the membership.

Chef Taylor referenced the #TCACARES service project at the Tarrant Area Food Bank and encouraged future host chapters to have a service project that benefits the local community. Chris Belanger presented a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Jackson York, CEC, AAC. The General Session was adjourned at 9:33 am.
