Eligible applicants must possess and show proof of:

- Associate's degree in Culinary Arts and demonstrated competency in at least one area of specialization.
- Five (5) years' occupational experience in culinary field may substitute for the degree.
- All Adjunct Faculty positions require excellent oral (English), written (English) and interpersonal communication skills, experience writing recipes, syllabi, lectures, and exams, as well as the ability to teach, train, and coach students of varying abilities from diverse backgrounds. Bilingual (Spanish) highly preferred.
