## **Contributing Chapter of the Year**

**Award Objective**: To recognize a single chapter for their outstanding work within the community thru fundraising, charitable work and education which ultimately promotes the values of the Texas Chefs Association in the spirit of Isaac Pina. Revised January 2017

- 1. At the summer board meeting during the convention, each Director will present a summary of their chapter's activities for the past year that has contributed to the community.
- Voting will be by secret ballot and will be tabulated by a panel appointed by the president. The members of this panel must be members of the board. They cannot be the director, interim director or proxy to vote on behalf of a chapter.
- 3. A chapter cannot win two consecutive years.
- 4. The winning chapter will receive a traveling trophy which will be returned the following year to be awarded to the next winner.

- Holding events to raise funds for community needs
- Providing volunteer labor, supplies or products for a community event
- Raising money through donations or any other specific need
- Organizing. Sponsoring or creating a means of improving an approved organization
