JOB DESCRIPTION

Summary/Objective

Responsible for assisting the Executive Chef and 1st Cook in meal production. Must be able to work independently. Performs all 2nd Cook duties to meet the standards of the Performance Work Statement and the 2nd Cook Training and Certification form.

Essential Functions

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- 1. Responsible for food production regarding:
 - Development of a working plan to meet production needs
 - Performance of meal preparation duties as assigned by Executive Chef and 1st Cook
- 2. Establish proficiency with required documentation including:
 - WSC (Work Services Corporation) 1005 Storeroom Requisition Form
 - CAFE (Corporate Automated Food Enterprise) Production Log
 - CAFE Master Menu
 - Net-Chef[®] recipe cards
- 3. Understands and follows knife safety.
- 4. Maintains sanitation standards to ensure food safety and compliance with Performance Work

Statement and Food Code in the areas of:

- Line service areas
- Salad preparation areas
- Kitchen work areas and equipment utilized for meal production
- 5. Responsible for maintaining and documenting all temperatures of products being prepared and served.
- 6. Assumes line-serving duties as required.

- 8. Performs other job-related duties as required by management.

Oversight Responsibility

This position has no supervisory responsibility.

This position is responsible for ensuring the successful completion of meal production requirements in coordination with the Cook's Helpers and other applicable kitchen staff.

Work Environment

This job operates in a food service environment. The employee is exposed to a variety of conditions such as significant heat and / or cold, exposure to moving mechanical parts and vibration, and the noise level in the work environment can be loud.

This role routinely requires the position holder to be familiar with the operation, safety, and basic troubleshooting requirements of all equipment utilized in the food service facility.

Physical Demands

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

The employee is required to walk, stand, reach, lift, bend, kneel, stoop, climb, and crouch for the duration of each shift. The employee is required to lift and carry items weighing 40 pounds frequently and up to 60 pounds occasionally. The position requires manual dexterity; auditory and visual skills; and the ability to follow written and oral instructions and procedures.
